WHAT IS A STATE REGISTERED PRE-APPRENTICESHIP?

- · Curriculum has been certified by the state
- Meets Act 158 graduation requirements
- FREE to all students
- Opens up paid work experience opportunities

WHAT IS IMT?

- IMT stands for Industrial Manfacturing Technician and covers four main topics.
 - Safety, Quality (IMT Pre-Apprenticeship)
 - Processes and Production, Maintenance Awareness (Advanced IMT Pre-Apprenticeship)
- The purpose of the IMT Pre-Apprenticeship is to help high school students begin a pathway to a career in manufacturing.

THIS PROGRAM COULD BE OFFERED IN YOUR DISTRICT

- Embedded into the classroom with curriculum or as an independent study.
- Students have the ability to receive 7 industry recognized certificates at the completion of both pre-apprenticeship programs.
- Proctored exams during class time.
- Tours of local manufacturing companies.
